**SUBJECT: John Connolly RV Park Operating Guidelines**

**POLICY STATEMENT**

The Town of Faro requires procedural guidelines in the daily operation of the John Connolly RV Park in order to ensure the safety and satisfaction of all users.

---

Park Administration

- 1) John Connolly RV Park (the park) is owned and managed by the Town of Faro
- 2) The Town of Faro staff has the authority to enforce all park rules and regulations.
- 3) Office hours are posted at the Campbell Region Interpretative Centre.
- 4) Rules and Regulations – Schedule “A”
- 5) Fee Schedule and Scheduled Events – Schedule “B”
- 6) This policy replaces #2002-2

## Schedule A

### Rules & Regulation

#### **Park Administration**

John Connolly RV Park (the park) is owned and managed by the Town of Faro

The Town of Faro employees have the authority to enforce all park rules and regulations.

Office hours are posted at the Campbell Region Interpretative Centre.

#### **Camper Behaviour**

Campers are expected to follow RV park rules and regulations for reasons of safety, health, respect for the campers and respect for campground property.

Registered campers are responsible for the behaviour of the people on their site and to insure visitors follow these rules and regulations.

Registered campers can be evicted by park staff at any time for violations of campground rules or regulations by themselves or their guests.

Unless otherwise agreed to by affected parties and management, quiet hours are from 11:00PM to 8:00AM. Music must be turned down and voices held to normal conversation level: no yelling, loud laughing, etc. Normally generators should also be shut off.

Campers under the age of 18 years of age should be under adult supervision at their respective campsites after 11:00PM. No campers under the 18 years of age should move from one site to another after 11:00PM without adult supervision.

Campers walking from one site to another after dark should show respect for other campers by being quiet.

If a camper feels a neighbouring campsite is excessively loud or obnoxious in any way, they are within their rights to request politely that the noisy camper quiet down. Any problems should be brought to the staff's attention as soon as possible.

Campers are responsible for leaving camp sites in clean condition. Place garbage in the receptacles provided.

Campers can stay in the campground a maximum of 21 (twenty-one) days. Campers who wish to stay for longer than 21 (twenty-one) days will be asked to move to the additional spaces on Sheldon Avenue.

Check out time is 11:00AM.

### **Identification & Registration**

All campers must register at the Campbell Region Interpretive Centre and provide photo identification. Any person failing to provide photo I.D (i.e. drivers licence) can be denied occupancy of a campsite.

### **Reservations**

Information pertaining to rental rates of campsites and camping reservation can be obtained through the Town of Faro at 867 994 2728 or the Campbell Region Interpretive Centre at 867 994 2288. Our camping Season is from the beginning of May to the middle of September each year.

### **Camper/Visitor/Campground Liability**

For the most part, the camping facility is unsupervised. The Town of Faro or its staff accept no legal liability for personal injury to the users of the park, nor property damage, theft of and/or vandalism with the use of the park.

All users of the park agree to assume all risks of personal injury, property damage, theft of and/or vandalism to property and hereby release the Town of Faro and its staff from any and all liability with the use of the park.

Campers assume full responsibility for their visitors.

### **Motorized Vehicles**

Vehicles licensed for highway driving must enter and leave the park from the main entrance onto Campbell Street. Vehicles which are assigned to the additional campground spaces on Sheldon Avenue will be directed to those sites by the Town of Faro staff.

Campers will be allowed to use their ATV's within the park grounds. Camper's visitors will also be allowed to bring ATV's into the campground.

All vehicles, including ATV's, must be licensed for highway driving and must be operated by a licensed driver. A licensed driver must accompany any driver with a 'beginner license'

Vehicles are only allowed on roadways within the campground or camp sites. Visitors vehicles must be parked in a manner that does not obstruct or interfere with other campers using the road way. Vehicles are not to be parked on reserved sites.

### **Speed Limit**

The maximum speed within the campground will be 15 kph.

### **Penalties for Speeding**

Penalties for speeding will be governed by the General Penalty Section 26(a) of Town of Faro bylaw 72-48.

### **Bicycles**

Use of bicycles within the park after dark is discouraged. If bicycles are required after dark, bicycle lights **must** be in operation.

Bicycle operators should exercise caution, due diligence and respect with regard to fellow cyclists, pedestrians, motorized vehicles and right to privacy of campers.

Site renters will be held responsible for the behaviour of cyclists at their site.

### **Drinking Water**

Potable water is at hookup sites. Potable water can also be obtained at the washrooms.

### **Noise Regulations**

All campers have the right to enjoy their campsite in relative peace and quiet without interference for excessive noise, yelling or loud music from neighbours. Music, T.V., voice or other socializing sounds should be kept to the minimum volume level possible for a camper's enjoyment so that neighbouring campers can do the same. As a norm, "if at any time, camper's voices or music can clearly be heard from the road, it is too loud".

During quiet time from 11:00PM to 8:00AM, socializing is allowed but music must be kept very low so as to not be heard from neighbouring sites and voices kept to quiet conversation tones. No yelling or loud laughing that could keep the neighbours or their children awake.

### **Electrical Generators**

Only inverter-type or generators deemed sufficiently quiet may be used in the park. Generators are not to be used during quiet time between 11:00PM and 8:00AM.

### **Dogs**

Dogs must be kept under control at all times and on a leash when walking around the campground. Dog owners are responsible for picking up and disposing of dog droppings in garbage bins.

### **Camp Fires**

Campfires **must** be attended at all times. Fires are allowed in camp-provided or approved fireplaces only. A fireplace cannot be moved to another location. The height of the fire must not exceed the height of the fireplace. Fire wood is for the use of campers and is not to be removed from the campground.

### **Trailer Dump Station**

Please respect others when dumping at the dump station. Use a hose to dump directly into the dump station.

### **Firearms**

Federal legislation must be adhered to in regards to rifles, handguns, shotguns, bb guns, pellet guns, paint ball guns, archery or cross bows, etc.

### **Respect for Nature**

The Town of Faro wished to maintain the campground as natural as possible. In order to meet this objective user cooperation is required. Do not damage the trees; removal of bark, axe cuts or nails shortens their life. Do not tie rope, string or cord of any kind to trees.

### **Wildlife Policy**

Do not feed or attempt to feed any wildlife. There may be wildlife such as foxes and bears that enter the campground.

### **Emergencies/After Hours**
